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## Country Overview

Iceland, a Nordic island nation, is defined by its dramatic landscape with volcanoes, geysers, hot springs and lava fields. Massive glaciers are protected in Vatnajökull and Snæfellsjökull national parks. Most of the population lives in the capital, Reykjavik, which runs on geothermal power and is home to the National and Saga museums, tracing Iceland's Viking history.

Iceland has more hot springs and solfataras—volcanic vents that emit hot gases and vapours—than any other country. Alkaline hot springs are found in some 250 areas throughout the country.



### Reykjavik, Iceland (4 nights)

Reykjavik, on the coast of Iceland, is the country's capital and largest city. It's home to the National and Saga museums, tracing Iceland's Viking history. The striking concrete Hallgrímskirkja church and rotating Perlan glass dome offer sweeping views of the sea and nearby hills. Exemplifying the island's volcanic activity is the geothermal Blue Lagoon spa, near the village of Grindavik.


### **DAY 2 - FOOD & CITY TOUR**

The beauty of Iceland's cuisine will rival the grandeur and majesty of Iceland's endless, gorgeous landscapes with every bite. We will visit six local restaurants featuring a mix of Icelandic cuisine, all while intermittently taking a look at some of Reykjavik's most illustrious attractions.

Our menu features Icelandic homemade ice cream, grass fed, free-roaming Icelandic lamb which generations of locals have enjoyed, seafood soup, the famous hot dog with "everything" that can beat Chicago, and fantastic cheeses constantly changing throughout the year.

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## **DAY 3 - GOLDEN CIRCLE (SUPER JEEP & SNOW MOBILE)**

The Golden Circle tour gives you the chance to see some of Iceland's most incredible natural wonders. From Reykjavik, we will set off to the famous Golden Circle: the scenic journey will take about 40 minutes, but don't worry there are plenty of things to see along the way.

We will begin by visiting the Thingvellir National Park, which is both steeped in history and stunningly beautiful. There you will see the historic site of Althingi, site of the world's oldest operational parliament. From Thingvellir, we will move on to the iconic geothermal area around Geysir hot spring: here you will see the incredible Geysers throw water and steam up to 25 meters into the air. After Geysir we will travel on to Gullfoss (the Golden Waterfall).

Finally we will kick things up a notch, by snowmobiling around Langjökull, Iceland's second biggest glacier. Langjökull, is the perfect end to the perfect day, combining stunning beauty with the fun of riding a snowmobile.
